WHAT TO BRING:

PCB capacitors	Car wax	Airplane glue
Metal powders	Polishes	Fiberglass resin
Organic powders	Driveway sealer	Photo chemicals
Paint (oil-based & latex)	Roofing tar	Chemistry sets
Stains & varnishes	Swimming pool chemicals	Furniture polish
Wood preservatives	Poisons	Floor & metal polish
Paint strippers/thinners	Insecticides	Oven cleaner
Solvent adhesives	Fungicides	Drain & toilet cleaner
Lighter fluid	Chemical fertilizers	Spot remover

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

Asbestos	Compressed Gas Cylinders/Propane
Ammunition, Fireworks, Explosives	Tires*
Radioactives, Smoke Detectors	Antifreeze*
Infectious & Biological Wastes	Waste Motor Oil*
Prescription Drugs/Syringes	Car Batteries*
Commercial or Industrial Waste	Household Alkaline Batteries*
Empty Containers	Cooking Oil*

*These items may be disposed of at the TEaM Transfer Station at 101 Spring Hill Road.

HOW TO SAFELY TRANSPORT THESE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS:

- Bring materials in original containers – securely closed.
- Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper, if necessary.
- Never mix chemicals together.
- Never smoke or eat while handling hazardous materials.
- Leaking or broken containers must be contained.
- Do not leave vehicles unless instructed to do so.
