Good evening, this is First Selectman Ken Kellogg with a brief update on the COVID-19 situation. In Monroe, we currently have a total of 6 laboratory- confirmed cases, and we continue to update this number daily on the Town's website. We should all expect to have additional cases in the days ahead, just as other towns in Fairfield County are experiencing.

I want to emphasize the Governor's order that now limits social and recreational gatherings to no more than **five** people. While our parks and trails have plenty of open space to enjoy safely, you must maintain social distancing. I implore everyone to follow these requirements, so that further restrictions do not become necessary.

As we get ready for another week of living in a way that may have seemed unimaginable less than a month ago, remember to focus on what we can control.
