GOVERNOR DELAYS OPENING OF HAIR SALONS AND BARBERSHOPS

Earlier this afternoon, the Governor announced that he would not allow hair salons and barbershops to open on May 20th as originally planned. During a subsequent press briefing, he stated that June 1st is the new target date for those businesses. In announcing this, the Governor stated that this decision is based upon feedback received from salon owners and employees.
