I'm happy to report that we have gone a full week without any new COVID-19 cases, as reported by the State Department of Public Health. That said, new cases continue to be reported in Fairfield County. We must recognize that the pandemic is not over, and remember to practice the safety guidelines as we look forward to phase 2 of the state's re-opening on Wednesday.

We continue to work on the phased re-opening of Town facilities. I'm pleased to announce that our team has a plan to open both the Wolfe Park pool and Great Hollow Lake in early July. To be consistent with the state rules, there will be some changes. The Parks & Recreation Department will be posting information on their website in the near future on pool operations during this unusual season.
