CASE TOTALS IN MONROE AS REPORTED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH

New cases: <i>Since last weekly report</i>	4
Total cases:	117

The State has highlighted the fact that a study by Covid ActNow lists Connecticut as one of only four states being categorized as “on track to contain COVID.” This is in stark contrast to many states in our country where COVID-19 is increasing, and in some states quite dramatically.
