UPDATES

- Connecticut has seen stability in in new cases and stability in testing positivity over the last week. State reports have indicated that while cases fell in 5 of 8 counties, they rose in Hartford and Fairfield counties.
- While recent contact tracing has not indicated any prevailing common theme in the limited number of cases in Monroe, many cases in Fairfield County have been linked to travel, gatherings at places of worship, and youth sports leagues.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Reminders on certain other state rules that remain in effect:
 - Private social gatherings remain limited to 25 indoors and 100 outdoors.
 - Outdoor organized events limited to 500 people with 15 feet of space “blanket to blanket.”
