### COVID-19 Pandemic Update May 28, 2021

- Monroe's 2-week rolling case rate has dropped slightly, now averaging exactly 1 new case per day.
- Our 2-week case is 5.1 cases per 100,000 population.
- As of yesterday's report, Monroe has had 1,414 cases, and 16 deaths, since the start of the pandemic.
- We continue to offer vaccination clinics for adults age 18 and over on Wednesdays. Appointments may be made through VAMS, but are no longer necessary. Walk-ins are welcome from 9am – noon.
