COVID-19 Pandemic Update November 5, 2021

- Case rates in Monroe are now down to an average of approximately 1½ new cases per day.
- We are scheduling a clinic for Monroe residents aged 65 and older to receive booster doses. We will be providing Moderna vaccine.
 - We are currently contacting Monroe seniors 65+, who received their initial vaccine series from one of our town-sponsored clinics, to schedule appointments. If we have been unable to reach you by phone or email, and you are age 65 or older, you may leave a message at 203-452-2818 and someone will return your call.
 - We will be scheduling booster clinics for all eligible individuals in the future.
- Final approval has been given for Pfizer vaccine for children age 5-11.
 - Based upon the feedback from parents, the Monroe Health Department will be conducting a clinic for this group.
 - Families should be on the lookout for another email next week through School Messenger with information on how to sign up. Parents of Monroe students who do not attend school in Monroe may email VaxHelp@MonroePS.org.
- Whether you are looking for a booster, or initial vaccination for all ages, there are now many other options in Monroe and in the surrounding area.
